How many of you know someone who gossips? Have heard someone gossiping? Of course we have WHY?

Let's look at what the Bible has to say about it....

"Rumors are dainty morsels that sink deep into one's heart." Proverbs 18:8 Gossip is so subtle it can just sneak up on you before you know you're even doing it. Many times we try to disguise gossip:

- Let people know so they can be praying,

## Who does Gossip Hurt?

## Gossip hurts the <u>person</u> it's <u>spoken</u> about .

"A troublemaker plants seeds of strife; gossip separates the best of friends." Proverbs 16:28

Maybe for you someone shared a secret crush you had on someone, personal struggle, or maybe someone shared on social media something you really wish they wouldn't have because it was embarrassing.

Should you ever find yourself the victim of other people's bitterness, smallness, or insecurities just remember it could be worse...you could be them!

## Gossip hurts the <u>listener</u>.

"<u>Wrongdoers</u> eagerly listen to gossip; <u>liars</u> pay close attention to slander." Proverbs 17:4

## Gossip hurts the <u>speaker</u>.

"When arguing with your neighbor, don't betray another person's secret. Others may accuse you of gossip, and you will <u>never regain your good reputation</u>." Proverbs 25:9-10

## How to control Gossip?

**Guard Your <u>Ears</u>** How to stop Gossip with one question: Why are you telling me this?

#### If that question feels a little too combative for you then ask this: Ask: Have you spoke with \_\_\_\_\_ about this?

""If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back." Matthew 18:15
